

Dear friends,

I started volunteering for Refuge in October 2000. The first conference that I attended for pregnancy centers was in 2001. At the Conference we were given a plaque with the prayer of Jabez engraved on it. It's a very simple prayer. "And Jabez called on the God of Israel saying. 'Oh, that You would bless me indeed, and enlarge my territory, that Your hand would be with me, and that You would keep me from evil, that I may not cause pain.' So, God granted him what he requested." (1 Chronicles 4:10)

I didn't know at the time how important that prayer would be for this ministry. Around 2004 God showed me a vision of growth for Refuge. I made a list of everything that I thought God was wanting us to offer our clients. It was a lot! He opened my eyes to see the great need throughout our community.

I took my ideas to the Director at the time, and she said, "Angela that's too big we will never be able to have that much money to do all those services". But I carried that dream in my heart for a long time. In 2016, when I was blessed to be named the Executive Director, I finally understood what she meant. At times, we barely scraped by to pay the staff, and many times we didn't have enough funds to pay our utilities. That is when I began to pray the prayer of Jabez for our ministry.

As we close out 2023, and begin our 40th year of ministry in 2024, I have to take time to look back in awe of how far we have traveled. Oh He has blessed us indeed! We are on the edge of moving to a new physical space. While that space is not that much larger, our territory will be enlarged. Through the collaboration and partnerships with Restoration Storehouse we will be able to provide more assistance to the families that seek help at Refuge.

Our hope is to see the fulfillment of the Lord's plans for this ministry. As He provides in His timing, we hope to add these services in the future: <u>STI Testing</u>, <u>Abortion Pill Reversal</u>, <u>Maternity Home</u> for homeless clients, <u>Pre-natal Care</u>, and free <u>Women's Wellness</u> check ups.

I know these are lofty goals. But nothing is impossible with God! So as we move forward into the fifth decade of this ministry, we ask you to continue to pray for the Lord's guidance and provision for Refuge. We place our hope in the stirring of Holy Spirit in our community. We have been blessed with some fantastic and generous friends and partners over the years. We will need many more. In order to reach the vision that has been set before us it will take many hands at the plow...volunteers, skilled staff, and financial resources to fund the services.


Thank you friends for all that you have generously provided for the families in our community through Refuge. We will continue to pray for you and your family as you pray for ours!



As prices of basic goods rise the dollars stretch less. We saw a record 918 client visits for material needs in 2023. Refuge is so thankful for our generous supporters that have provided an abundance of baby items to help our clients. We couldn't do it without you!



## Practical PARENTING

74% of women who consider abortion state that financial concerns are the main reason for doing so.

The parenting classes offered by The Refuge Center are making a significant impact in our community. Mothers and fathers are learning valuable parenting and life skills through a convenient on-line curriculum developed by Brightcourse. In recent years, we have seen an explosion in the desire for Earn While You Learn parenting classes. In 2017 we provided 194 lessons to parents in house. That number has tremendously increased. In 2023 we provided a record 2,966 lessons to parents seeking education for Practical Parenting. Mothers and Fathers have over 200 lessons to choose from. Thank you for your support. We could not provide this valuable service without you!



48 wonderful, sweet spirited volunteers have provided an average of 132 hours per week in 2023. This equals 6,864 unpaid man hours given by our community. In addition, \$132,647 was donated in the form of materials and supplies.



The annual Baby Bottle Campaign is our main community fundraiser that we hold each year. We strive to make it as simple as possible for all who are involved. On average this fundraiser provides 25-35% percent of our operating budget each year.
